TIPS AND METHODS

YORKSHIRE GRIT PASTE AKA EEE ULTRA SHINE WAX AKA 4-1-1 BW SANDING PASTE

presented by Ron D'Aunov

YORKSHIRE GRIT PASTE: 227 grams (8 oz) - weight \$ 24.95 English - Yorkshire-grit.com plus shipping U.S.A. - thewalnutlog.com EEE ULTRA SHINE WAX: 250 ml (8.6 oz) - volume \$ 24.95 Australian made plus shipping U.S.A. - Craft Supplies, Pennstate, Packard, etc. 4-1-1 BW SANDING PASTE: 22.5 ounces - weight about 8.00 Homemade from mineral oil, bees wax & diatomaceous earth. What you need: 1 16 oz bottle of mineral oil (weights about 15 c \$ 2.00 3.75 oz bees wax (1 pound about \$13) 3.75 oz food grade diatomaceous earth (1 pound Swansons - Walmart about \$13) 3.00 8.00

You will also need a digital scale, a double boiler, a paint paddle, containers for packing

WHAT DO YOU USE IT FOR:

- 1 as a final sanding on wood & acrylics to remove the scratches.
- 2 as a final finish on pens, finials, bottle stoppers, small bowls/boxes.
- 3 as a polish for CA finishes and fully cured other final finishes.
- APPLY IT using a paper towel to a slowly rotating piece, turn speed up let it heat up and buff in.
- WHAT FINAL FINISHES CAN BE APPLIED OVER THESE SANDING PASTES Lacquer, shellac, various friction polishes.
